

As UIS Subang Jaya is transitioning to a 6 year primary programme from the current 5 year programme, students who are enrolling for Early Years and Primary Year 1 commencing from academic year 2021/ 2022 will undergo a 6-year primary programme. Those who are enrolling into Primary Year 2-5 will undergo the current 5-year primary programme.



EARLY YEARS CURRICULUM

(EYC 1-2)

The International Primary Curriculum (IPC) Early Years Programme was written by practising early years specialists and provides the same mix of practical, rigorous support for teachers and exciting, appropriate work for children as the IPC main programme. The Early Years Programme also helps children to become familiar with the IPC learning process for each unit and better prepare them for progression to the IPC main programme.

Based on the very best early years practice, the IPC Early Years units of work help children develop in a way which is wholly appropriate for their age. The Early Years Programme is offered for students age 4-6, and serves as an introduction for the Year 1 IPC units.

(Year 1-5)

In the primary level, students follow the Cambridge Primary Curriculum of English, Mathematics and Science, as well as the International Primary Curriculum (IPC). The IPC is a comprehensive, thematic, creative curriculum with a clear process of learning and with specific learning goals for every unit. These learning goals include:

Subject Goals



(Years 6-10)

Cambridge Secondary Level builds upon the learning in Cambridge Primary Level and develops children's knowledge in these core subjects. The Secondary School curriculum is divided into two stages: Cambridge Secondary (Year 6-8) and Cambridge IGCSE (Year 9-10).
